### The Power of Reading!



Creating a love of reading in children is potentially one of the most powerful ways of improving academic standards in school.

There can be few better ways to improve pupils chances in school, or beyond in the wider world, than to enable them to become truly independent readers.



## Reading requires two skills:



#### **Phonics and Word Recognition**

The ability to recognise words presented in and out of context.

The ability to blend letter sounds (phonemes) together to read words.

Understanding the Concepts of Print.

#### **Understanding**

The ability to understand the meaning of the words and sentences in a text.

The ability to understand the ideas, information and themes in a text.

If a child understands what they hear, they will understand the same information when they read.

## StoryTime Phonics


- At Valence we use StoryTime Phonics to support our children develop their early reading skills of decoding, through a systematic learning of phonics.
- The children learn to recognise letter shapes (graphemes) and the corresponding sound (phoneme). They also learn the corresponding capital letter and its letter name.
- Children then build on this phonic knowledge (including digraphs and trigraphs) to then blend the sounds together to read words (decode).










### How do we teach reading at school?




## How do we teach Reading at School?

I spy with my little eye, a word that begins with w.



How do we teach reading at school?

We read quality texts, which expose children to rich vocabulary.



# What is comprehension? We encourage children to read for meaning.

Comprehension is the ability to understand something.

If your child can tell you about what they have read; it is clear that they are working towards good comprehension skills.

## Reading at home with your child.

- We really appreciate the time that you spend at home reading with your child.
- Always try and sit with your child on your left when you read.
- Encourage your child to point to each word as it is read. If they are not sure of a word ask then to use their sounds to try and decode the word.
- Look at the pictures to give meaning to the words in the text, as this can help to support their understanding.
- Ask your child to retell the story to you, using the pictures if they want to.
- Ask questions to check their understanding of the story. The questions can be both retrieval and inference questions.




