



THEME: The Ancient Egyptians

HOMEWORK

Please read with your child and discuss what they have read at least three times a week. Please sign their reading record. Pick and Mix homework has a range of activities across the curriculum. Children should choose one of these activities every week to complete.

Every month there are optional Maths and Science challenges that can be completed and either brought back into school or uploaded onto Class Dojo.

PE

Our topics this half term are Basketball and Tag Rugby.

RE & PSHE

In RE we are looking at light in religion focussing on the festivals of Diwali, Hanukkah and Christmas / Advent.

PSHE this half term is following the Jigsaw scheme of Celebrating Differences.

COMPUTING

This term pupils will use a range of techniques to create a stop-frame animation using tablets. They will apply these skills to create a story-based animation adding other types of media such as music and text.

LITERACY

This half term we will be:

- Looking at the features of a fairy tale.
- Reading the story 'The Egyptian Cinderella' and writing an alternative ending to the story.
- Reading the story 'The Boy King' and 'Howard and the Mummy'
- Writing a non-chronological report about 'The Ancient Egyptians'

We will continue to read for pleasure and develop our comprehension skills. Please continue to support your child with reading at home.

HISTORY

This half term our topic will be 'The Ancient Egyptians'.

We will be:

- Locating Egypt on a world map
- Learning the key dates for when the Ancient period began and ended.
- Learning about the daily life of Ancient Egyptians focusing on;
 - Gods and Beliefs
 - Homes and Education
 - Achievements and Inventions
- Finding out about Tutankhamun and what was discovered in his tomb
- Discovering how the Egyptians mummified the dead

MATHS

This half term we will be looking at:

- Length
- Perimeter
- 3-digit addition and subtraction
- Ordering and comparing 3-digit numbers
- Revising our 2, 5 and 10 timetables.

CREATIVE ARTS (Art/Music)

In Art this half term the children will be improving upon their sketching and painting skills by creating a portrait of King Tutankhamun.

The children will be using their modelling skills to make a canopic jar out of clay.

In Music we will be following the scheme Charanga. The children will be exploring and developing their skills through playing the glockenspiel.

SCIENCE

Our topic this half term is 'Animals including Humans; Movement and Feeding'. The children will be:

- Learning about the skeleton and its three main uses.
- Naming the parts of the body associated with the skeleton and the muscles.
- Understanding that humans and animals need the right types and amounts of nutrition.
- Understanding that the foods we eat give us energy.
