Literacy

Your leaflet must give information about where the museum is, opening hours, exhibits, workshops etc. Use the National Army Museum website to help you to complete your leaflet. Add pictures or print photos from online and add to your leaflet.

Geography

Draw/trace a world map. Label the countries that were Allies and colour those countries in red. Label all the countries that were neutral and colour them in blue.

Label the countries that were part of the Central Powers and colour them green.

Maths

Complete the weekly maths homework.

History

Find out what British soldiers wore during WW1 whilst on the front lines. Find out about the equipment they carried. Draw and label their uniform, equipment and weapons the soldiers were given.

Art

Find out about WW1 medals and then create a WW1 medal using salt dough, play dough, paint or collage.

PSHE
